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Uniform Policy

Purpose

- To give the children a sense of belonging and pride in their school, we require students to dress within the guidelines of our dress code, which also reflects the DoE Policy.
- Give students a sense of belonging and pride in their school.
- Promote safety through easier identification of students.
- Keep cost of clothing within reasonable levels.
- Assist students to learn the importance of appropriate presentation.
- Ensure equity standards in diversity.

Policy

The school colours are gold and black.

The policy applies to all students PP to Year 6.

All items of clothing are to be marked with the child's full name

Uniform Shop

Price lists are available online from our website.

A uniform shop is run onsite by the P&C and is open twice per week.

The school dress code is as follows:

Gold short or long-sleeved polo shirt

Black 125th Anniversary Polo Shirt

Black trousers/pants or shorts – no jeans or denim

Black skirt or skort

Black windcheater, sweater or jacket (no brand logos)

Sneakers or black shoes, and suitable flat sandals in summer

Black wide-rimmed hat.

Coloured faction t-shirts are for school sports days and are optional for Friday sports.

Hair

Long hair must be tied back at all times for health and safety reasons.

Jewellery

Jewellery, except for ear studs or sleepers, is not permitted. Loss is always disappointing. Jewellery is an OSH safety issue in daily student activities. Exceptions can be made via the principal for cultural or religious reasons.

Nail polish

Coloured nail polish is strongly discouraged as it is a hygiene concern.

Excursions

Students must be in full school uniform on all excursions for easy identification.
